- The SAO, subject to approval of Council, may require deposits, prepayment for estimated services, or rejection of services to any customer who has <u>any</u> outstanding amounts of accounts receivable owing to the Hamlet for a period greater than 90 days.
- 7. All invoiced amounts for services or materials, will be subject to interest of 2 (two) percent per month for amounts outstanding for more than 30 days. Terms are net 30.
